Eichen Crutchlow Zaslow, LLP is one of the most successful plaintiff's law firms in New Jersey. From high-profile automobile tragedies and class actions to birth injuries, the firm's lawyers have a proven track record of excellence by securing record-setting results and maximum compensation for their clients. The firm's lawyers represented James McNair, a comedian and mentor to actor Tracy Morgan, who was killed during a collision with a truck driven by a Wal-Mart employee in 2014. The tragedy on the NJ Turnpike made national headlines and the confidential, out-of-court settlement with Wal-Mart was recovered by Zaslow on behalf of McNair's family in 2015. Additionally, Zaslow achieved a \$5.5 million landmark verdict on behalf of a child who sustained a birth injury to her brachial plexus—one of the largest ever obtained in an Erb's Palsy or shoulder dystocia case.

The firm has also demonstrated courtroom prowess by representing local governments in major actions. For example, Eichen obtained a \$51 million verdict on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in 2010 following a suit against Johnson & Johnson for overcharging Medicaid recipients. This verdict led to the Commonwealth further recovering hundreds of millions of dollars.

"No case is too big, complex or expensive for our firm," Eichen said. "We have achieved great success representing high-profile clients. But we also truly believe that no client is too small to fight for after they have sustained significant damages."

The firm and its leaders have been honored by the media and legal community as well. *U.S. News – Best Lawyers* "Best Law Firms" has ranked the firm as Tier 1 in Medical Malpractice Law – Plaintiffs in New Jersey, and Tier 2 in both Mass Tort Litigation / Class Actions – Plaintiffs and Personal Injury Litigation – Plaintiffs in New Jersey.
